PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

AN EASTER EUCHARISTIC PRAYER AND THE LORD'S PRAYER

PRAYER AFTER RECEIVING

God of life, who to free us from our fixation on the materiality of life gave your only begotten Son to the death of the cross, and by his glorious resurrection have delivered us from the power that keeps us from giving our whole selves to your purpose for us: grant us so to die daily to our false selves that overvalue the material, that we may evermore live with him in the joy of his risen life and our true selves that honor you by responding faithfully to the movement of your Spirit, as he did; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
