How Great Thou Art and *Pass It On* were requested by Carrie Staubus. Kurt Kaiser, is the author of *Pass It On* and is an award winning songwriter of Contemporary Christian music and member of the Gospel Music Hall of Fame. He has produced and arranged albums for the likes of: Kathleen Battle, Ernie Ford, Larnelle Harris, Burl Ives, and Joni Eareckson Tada. Born in Chicago, Illinois, he attended The American Conservatory of Music. From there, he attended Northwestern University School of Music. From 1965 through 1970, Kaiser served as director of the Baylor Religious Hour Choir, whose current members include Richard Ashley. At the same time, Kurt Kaiser and his friend Ralph Carmichael began writing Christian rock musicals geared to reach out to the youth of the time. Their first musical, *Tell It Like It Is*, which included the song "Pass It On", sold 2,500 copies and completely sold out its first run. 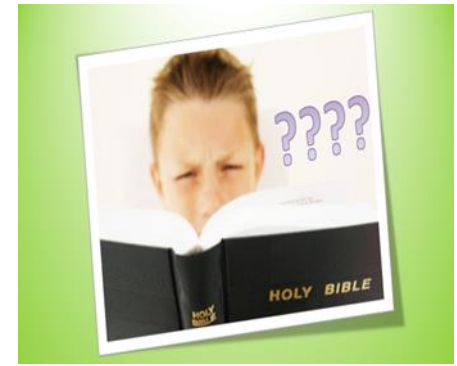
