PRESCHOOL NEWS —Three new programs for the 2021-22 school year!

Option 1: Preschool begins at 8:30 am and runs through 1:00 pm Monday - Friday. Our time from start through 11:00 is comprised of fine motor, gross motor and social emotional play-based learning with children divided by age and ability. Children bring a snack, snack lunch and




water bottle. After lunch through 1:00 pm is whole-group STEAM based thematic learning. Cost: \$750/month

Option 2: Preschool begins at 8:30 am and ends at 11:00 am Monday - Friday. This option is for children who are three years old. Cost: \$450/month **Option 3:** Kindergarten students may join us after their morning class, eat a sack lunch, and experience STEAM activities until 1:00 pm Monday - Friday. Cost: \$400 / month


